The Conference

The Ussher Society is pleased to announce that the 45th Annual Conference will be held at the **Hotel Rembrandt, Dorchester Road, Weymouth**, Dorset from the 3rd to the 6th of January 2007.

The four day event will cover earth and environmental sciences in the South West of England and will comprise field trips on Wednesday 3rd and Saturday 6th January and two days of presentations (talks and posters). The main presentation days will be Thursday 4th and Friday 5th of January - we now have a full timetable of talks, many thanks to those who have contributed. **Poster presentations** are still welcomed in all areas of geology, geomorphology, engineering geology and environmental geology, typically relating in some way to South West England. The Scott Simpson lecture on Thursday morning will be given by **Prof Richard Fortey**, President of the Geological Society of London and the joint half day session with the SW Regional Group of the Geological Society will take place on the Friday afternoon, based on the theme of '**Geo-Tourism**'.

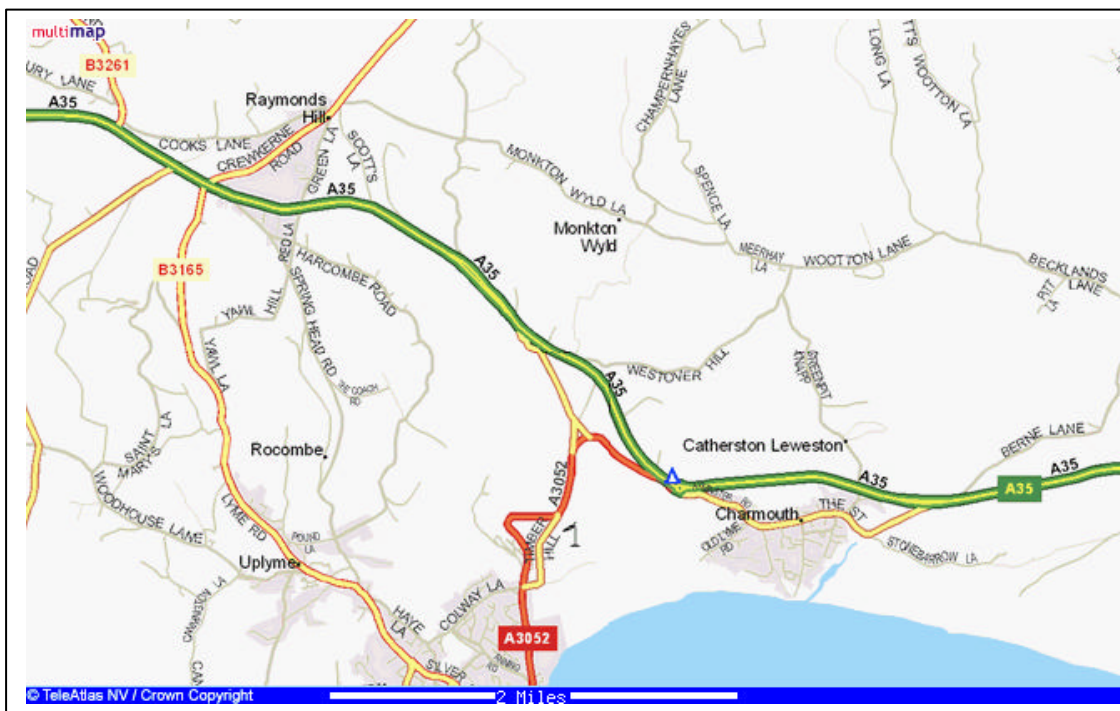
Morning:
